- Nadie está obligado a firmar ningún documento sin representación legal. (Derecho de la Sexta Enmienda)

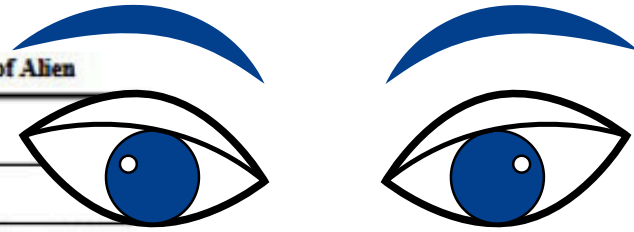

- Maintain custody of the alien for a period **NOT TO EXCEED 48 HOURS** beyond the time when he/she has been released from your custody to allow DHS to assume custody. The alien must be served with a copy of this detainer to take effect. This detainer arises from DHS authorities and should not impact decisions about rehabilitation, parole, release, diversion, custody classification, work, quarter assignments, or other matters.
- Relay this detainer to any other law enforcement agency to which you transfer custody of the alien.
- Notify this office in the event of the alien's death, hospitalization or transfer to another institution.

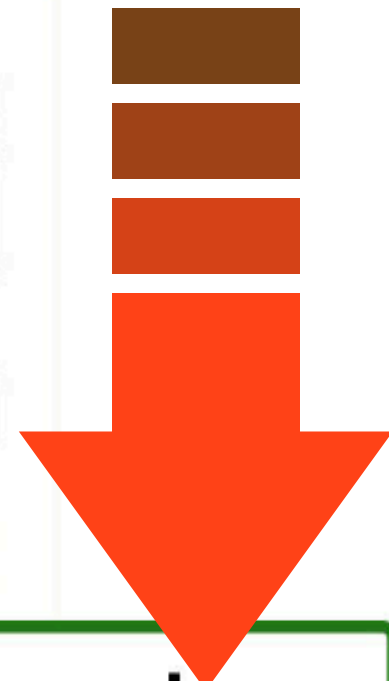

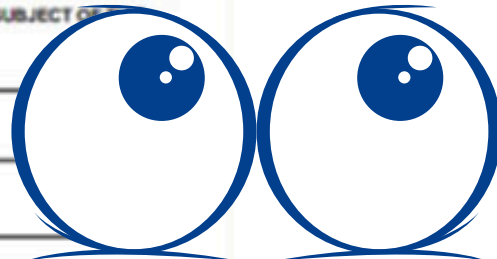
